Education State

Since 2018, the Andrews Labor Government has secured over \$50 million for school improvements across the Mount Waverley District.

- Playground upgrades at Mount Waverley Primary and Pinewood Primary.
- Upgrading our local Special Schools Glenallen, Ashwood School and Burwood East Special Development School.
- Free TAFE for over 60 courses, with many offered at the Holmesglen Institute in Chadstone.
- \checkmark \$2 million towards the Ballygriffin Senior Learning Centre at Avila College.
- \checkmark Shade sails for many of our local schools.
- Pinewood Early Years Hub. \checkmark
- Free kinder for three-and four-year olds starting next year.

Environment & Community

- There's a lot happening in our community, and I've been working hard to ensure we have the best public facilities, reserves, and play areas.
- Funded the creation and delivery of the Mount Waverley Reserve Master Plan.
- New scoreboard at Central Reserve.
- \checkmark Rebuilding the Brentwood Reserve sports pavilion.
- Lighting upgrade at Pinewood Reserve.
- \checkmark \$21 million towards the Glen Waverley Sports Hub.
- Shared bike user trail and new play space at Jells Park. \checkmark
- \checkmark Kooyongkoot-Gardiners Creek Master Plan
- \checkmark Over \$100 million towards the redevelopment of the State Basketball Centre.
- ✓ Supported new facilities for the Monash Men's Shed and Waverley Woodworkers.

Health & Wellbeing

As your local MP I am working to make sure our suburbs have the local services and supports they need to keep safe and well.

- Delivered the Waverley Ambulance Station, opened in 2021.
- **GP-led Priority Primary** Care Centre, as part of a \$14.3 million plan to deliver care and ease pressure on our busy emergency departments.
- Converting Bellbird Private Hospital in Blackburn into a dedicated public elective surgery centre, helping an additional 5,700 Victorians to get the surgical care they need each year.
- Respiratory Clinic in Glen Waverley. \checkmark
- 5 Mobile Stroke Unit, based in Melbourne's South Eastern suburbs.
- 1 Recruited 24,000 extra healthcare workers since coming to government.

We've delivered record funding and landmark reform for mental health. The Andrews Labor Government has committed to implementing all 74 recommendations of the Royal Commission into Victoria's Mental Health System.

Transport & Infrastructure

We've delivered on local transport and infrastructure in a number of ways:

- Delivered \$2.3B for Suburban Rail Loop Early Works. Upgraded Monash Freeway to add new lanes to the Monash Freeway, and widening the bridge above Forster Road.
- Committed over \$1.4 million to deliver amenity upgrades at Glen Waverley Station.
- Delivered 40 new and upgraded car park spaces at Jordanville Station.
- Delivered 66 Level Crossing Removals as part of our plan to remove 85 level crossings across metropolitan Melbourne.
- Invested in active transport, including Clayton to Syndal Strategic Cycling Corridor and the Pipe Trail Pedestrian Crossing.
- the Kew to Oakleigh bus service to improve access for students at Ashwood High School.
- New turning arrows at the intersection of Huntingdale Road and Waverley Road.
- ✓ 40k Safety Signage at Blackburn Road, Syndal.

The Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) is a game changer for our State, and it begins here in our local community. SRL East will connect Glen Waverley to Monash University, Deakin University, Monash Hospital. The project will create around 24,000 and create a more connected Melbourne for small businesses, students, and connect our community by 2035.

Only an Andrews Labor Government will deliver the Suburban Rail Loop.

Social & Affordable Housing

The Andrews Labor Government has introduced a number of measures to help first home buyers get into the market sooner.

- \checkmark Victorian Home Buyer Fund shared equity scheme.
- Abolished stamp duty for eligible first home buyers.
- \$50 million funding boost for new housing projects for youth experiencing or at risk of homelessness.
- Council Rate Cap. \checkmark
- Underguoting Blitz.

We've also introduced more than 130 reforms to make renting fairer and safer, including:

- Minimum safety requirements.
- Limiting rent increases
- Putting an end to rental
- bidding.
- A cap on bonds.
- The right to have a pet.
- The right to hang pictures, attach child safety devices, and install LED globes.
- Improving greater housing options through Build-to-Rent incentives and the Affordable Housing Rental Scheme.

Ashwood High School Bus Service and Entry Point

Thanks to your support, the Route 624 Kew to Oakleigh bus will deviate to provide services to Ashwood High School at peak times in the mornings and afternoons on weekdays! This will make it easier and safer for students to get to and from school.
